The regular maze can be a little overwhelming, so we have created a special trail through the corn for families with younger kids. Along the journey you will be reading story boards of "Jack and the Cornstalk". It will be a fun adventure!

4. 1 Pumpkin of student's choice from "Granny's Gourds."

*Student must be able to carry pumpkin by himself/herself.

5. Learn while touring the 3 types of corn that we grow – Field Corn, Sweet Corn and Popcorn.
6. Choose a topic: Pumpkin Pollination or The Parts of Corn. You will then become "Honorary Farmers" for the day!
7. Crank the handle of the Gee Family's corn sheller.
8. Crank the handle of a wheat grinder and grind whole wheat flour. Learn the parts of wheat, too!
9. Corn shucking contest.
10. Giant Hay Slide.
11. Learn while touring the cotton and milo fields.
12. "Sally's Corn Shootin' Range."
13. "Bobby's Big Jump" Pillow.
14. Corn Tunnel – Walk thru the hay tunnel and learn the life cycle of corn.
15. Tractor – hop inside our biggest tractor on the farm.
16. Ride the "Kernel Express."
17. Tour our Sweet Corn harvesting equipment.
18. Tour "The First Hens" Coop. Learn about the women each hen is named after.
